



Professor Bruce Harry Bennett (1954-1958) attended Pembroke College for four years from 1964, six years after he left Hale.

A contemporary of Malcolm Treadgold, who was the tenth Haleian to become a Rhodes Scholar, Bruce became a School Prefect and Captain of Faulkner House in his final year. An accomplished sportsman, Bruce captained the cricket side and was also vice-captain of the football team.

In 1993 Bruce was appointed an Officer of the Order of Australia for services to education and Australian literature.

He held the position of Emeritus Professor in the School of Humanities and Social Sciences at the University of New South Wales at the Australian Defence Force Academy.

Bruce died recently, aged seventy one.
