



Professor Malcolm Lloyd Treadgold (1951-1958) left Christchurch College in 1965 with a Bachelor of Philosophy. He subsequently went on to become Senior Research Fellow at the Australian National University (1973-1975). He was the Professor of Economics at the University of New England and became a Commonwealth Fellow at St John's College, Cambridge in 1981.

As a Haleian, Malcolm had been both Captain of School and Dux in his final year. He had been captain of athletics and received Symbols for rowing. In contrast Malcolm had also been a member of the Cygnet and Drama committees.
