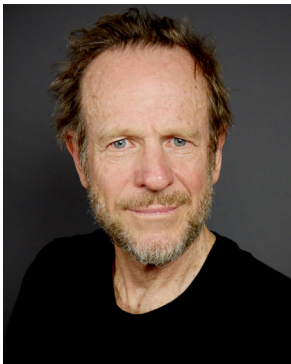
GUEST SPEAKER: JON DOUST

"In school, Dousty, you were such a hopeless boy."

This hopeless boy went on to write *Boy On A Wire* long listed for the 2010 Miles Franklin Literary Award. Since then he has written *To The Highlands* and *Return Ticket*.

In school Jon was sometimes punished for his exuberant, over activity, and his life is testament to the continuation of this trait.

He left home and security to live a hopeless life in South Africa, then a life of purpose, with gun in hand, for three years in Israel, and, finally, completed a BA in English at Curtin (then WAIT). This began a decade in journalism and community activism.

Jon was one of the foundation members of the Wilderness Society in WA; he started Laugh Resort Inc, still operating one of the longest running comedy rooms in Australia; he instigated the Manjimup Cherry Harmony Festival, now in its 18th year; and he is now in the 44th year of marriage to a woman he met on a kibbutz in 1976.

Jon lives in Albany, where he continues his life-long habit of bothering people in authority, swimming, body-surfing, reading, writing and making Turkish coffee. On the night he will tell you how Akos Kovacs lived so long and suggest why one should never judge a boy by early signs of hopelessness.
